Other important areas are e.g. **genomics and metagenomics, and regenerative medicine.** There is also highly advanced in fields like **bioengineering and biological surface chemistry**

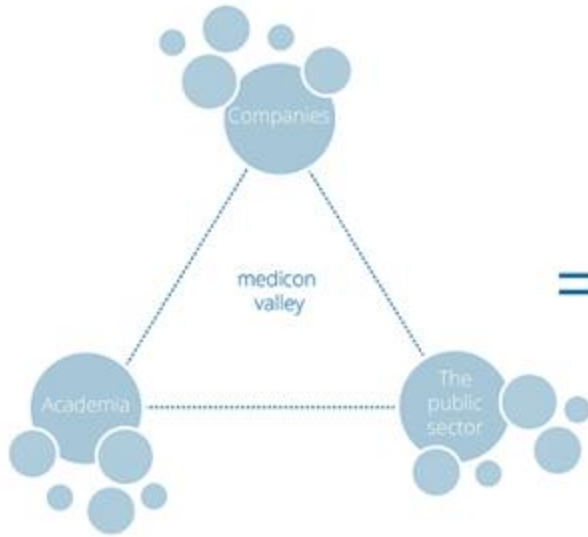

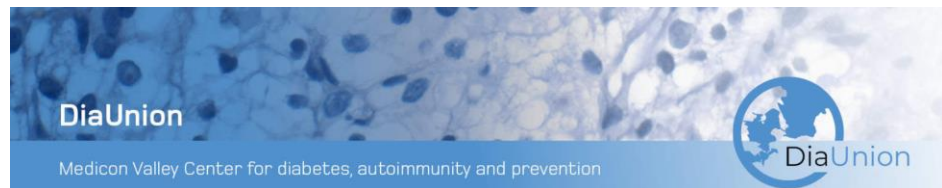
